Signs of Change: Assessment Past, Present and Future Another Time, Another Place...Examinations Then and Now In the Temple of Literature in Hanoi, Vietnam, a series of stone stelae records the names of the handful of illustrious examination candidates who, in each century, passed the national examination to become a Doctor of Literature. Beginning in the 11th century, the exams were conducted personally by successive kings who pursued Confucian ideals that found expression in the enormous value placed on the pursuit of wisdom and learning.
