Romances were among the most popular books in the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries among both Protestant and Catholic readers. Through careful examinations of the period's most renowned romances—Sir Philip Sidney's *The Countess of Pembroke's Arcadia*, Spenser's *The Faerie Queen*, William Shakespeare's *Pericles*, and Lady Mary Wroth's *Urania*—Werth illustrates how
